Dear Sir,

We moved to Surin in December 2020 to start our new life in this most peaceful and beautiful rural part of France.
At the time of purchasing our new home we were informed by our real estate agents Beaux Villages that there had been an application to install 8 wind turbines on the Surin to Chatain road.

We were informed at this point that this application had been refused. We were horrified to see that without any consultation to the residents that during 2024/2025 a number of 6 wind turbines were erected on this section of road and very close to our property. More recently we have been informed by a neighbour that an application has been motioned to install more wind turbines. At no point have we ever received any notifications of these works.

Is that because they know of all the objections they would receive??

We strongly object to the existing wind turbines or further installations of any more wind turbines for the following reasons,

- 1) We would never have purchased our property in Surin knowing that our peace, outlook and health would be so directly affected.
- 2) The noise which these wind turbines produce is totally unacceptable and disturbs not only us but our family and friends that come to visit us as we originally described our setting as idyllic. We do not believe that these wind turbines are meeting the current noise regulations that are in force.
We often wake at night to sound of the blades whooshing which is not good for our well-being which was one of the main reasons for moving here which has now been taken away.
- 3) After seeking advice from 3 separate real estate agents in France we have been advised that the location of the existing wind turbines being close to our home will have a direct impact on the resale value of our property.
- 4) It would appear the only people who benefit greatly from these wind turbines are the greedy farmers and the electricity supply companies who are making significant profits. Where is the compensation to us the residents who have to look at them, hear them, have a detrimental affect on their and have a reduced value of their properties because of them?

In a 7km radius from Surin there are currently 35 wind turbines. Is that already not enough???

These wind turbines are a huge eyesore in the landscape spoiling the beautiful countryside and impacting on wildlife.

We reiterate, local residents have no say in the installation of these eye sores, we have no knowledge of the plans, just greedy farmers lining their pockets as are the electricity supply companies whilst your residents are receiving no compensation or discount on their electricity whilst having to suffer all of the above.

We will strongly object to any further applications for additional wind turbines.

We would gladly welcome any response to the above or the opportunity to discuss this further with you.
